Topics to be covered include, stock preparation, basic dovetail tools, layout, dovetail joinery, and finishing. Participants are requested to bring a set of sharp woodworking chisels. All other materials will be provided. In addition each person will receive the workshop guide which is a step by step tutorial of everything that is covered in our workshop. This two day workshop is divided into two consecutive weekends. Participants will learn how to strip and refinish a piece of their choosing. Each participant will receive a refinishing kit which will contain all the necessary materials to strip and refinish and average size piece of furniture.
